3 person	\$24,400 - \$64,800
4 person	\$26,200 - \$72,000
5 person	\$28,000 - \$77,800
6 person	\$29,800 - \$83,600
7 person	\$31,600 - \$89,300
8 person	\$33,400 - \$95,100
