The Stockbridge-Munsee Community, a federally-recognized Indian Tribe, is seeking proposals from qualified firms/individuals to draft archeological curation policies, procedures (including a competitive fee table), and make recommendations for the Historical Preservation Offices' existing facilities to meet industry standards. This will involve on-site assessment and cataloguing of the existing collections, which includes archeological materials and paper records. The Historical Preservation Offices are located in Bowler, Wisconsin and Troy, New York.

Work will take place in Bowler, Wisconsin on the Stockbridge-Munsee Indian Reservation and Troy, New York.
